Please pick and choose from these homework tasks every week. Can you complete at least one per week and bring the evidence in each Thursday.

Reading Focus: Reading for pleasure/ fluency	Read your favourite book with an adult. Write a review telling me what you liked / disliked about it.	Visit the library and choose a non-fiction book about natural disasters. Take a picture of you with your book.	Learn a short poem by heart to perform to the rest of the class.
Writing Focus: Capital letters and full stops, adjectives, adverbs and conjunctions.	Write a shape poem about a natural disaster that we have not done yet. E.g. earthquake, tsunami, flood etc...	Write a diary about someone who has experienced a natural disaster.	Write as many words as you can from letters of the alphabet a-z about natural disasters. E.g. a = avalanche, b= boiling, c = core etc...
Maths Focus: number and four operations.	Practise your times tables by singing some songs! (Google times table songs)	Show me different ways to make 3 digit numbers by painting or drawing Place value charts, base 10 or pictures of objects (hundreds, tens and ones).	Play a dice game with an adult. Who can be the first to make 100? How about 200? Write addition and subtraction sentences with the numbers that you make.
Geography Focus: worldwide	If you had 10 minutes to pack before a natural disaster, what would you pack and why?	Research a natural disaster and write a newspaper article about it.	Print out a map of the world and label some natural disasters that have happened.
History Focus: natural disasters timeline.	Write a fact file about Mt Vesuvius in Pompeii erupting. Include the date and year.	Create your own timeline about a specific volcano and when it has erupted over time.	Find out when the most famous natural disasters have occurred.
Art/ DT	Make a volcano out of different materials. Bring it in to school to display it.	Paint a picture or sketch a drawing of any natural disaster.	Create your own version of the Earth's structure. You could draw/ paint/ model it. Label it with the four different layers.
RE/PSHE Focus: Jigsaw- Being me	Write down three achievements that you are proud of in your life. Now write three targets for the end of Year 3 that you are going to try and achieve.	Draw a picture of yourself/ take a picture of yourself and label 10 interesting facts about you. E.g. I like.....My favourite food is.....My hobby is.....My hair colour is	Draw a picture of your ideal school, give it a name and pretend you are the Head teacher. Write a school charter of 5 school rules that you would have.
Science Focus: Rocks and fossils	Go rock/ fossil hunting and become a rock star detective; hunt for rocks on the beach etc... Take pictures of them and tell me where you found them and what type of rock it might be and why.	Explain how a fossil is formed, create a timeline of events.	Dig up some soil and investigate it in your garden. Research the different layers of soil, take a picture and label them. This can be done as a picture if you prefer.
