


Phonics	<p>Look through a story book and spot the sounds you know. Write them on a piece of paper.</p> <p>Circles: Phase 2 sounds. Go on a hunt and say the sounds you see. You could make a list on a piece of paper.</p> <p>Circles: s, a, t, p, u, i, n, m, d, g, o Triangles: z, w, y, x, ch, sh, th, ng, qu. Squares: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, oo, or.</p>
Reading	<p>Tricky Words: Tricky word bingo. Have a family member say a word. If it's on the sheet, dab it or circle it.</p> <p>Circles: I, the, no, go, to sheet. Triangles/squares: he, she, we, me, be sheet. Stars: Write a sentence with a tricky word in.</p>	<p>Reading for Pleasure: Circles, triangles and squares: Read your favourite story and create a story map to retell the story to a member of your family (see notes for an example). Stars: Write sentences about the beginning, middle and end of the story.</p>	<p>Decoding: Read the word or sentence and draw a picture in the box to show your understanding: Circles: man, dog, map bin sheet. Triangles: Phase 3 caption sheet (sh) Squares: sixteen trees sheet. Stars: a bag of crisps and a drink sheet.</p>	<p>Decoding: Use you're your phonics to read a comic: www.phonicsplaycomics.co.uk Circles: 'Pat' comic. Triangles: 'Buzz' comic Squares: 'I can spot' comic Stars: 'Moon camping' comic.</p>
Writing	<p>Letter formation: Circles, triangles, squares: If you have some chalk practise forming some letters outside in the sunshine. If not you could use paint or pens. Stars: write some words with the chalk, pens or paint.</p>	<p>Draw a picture: Draw a picture about anything you would like to. Circles: Add initial sounds or labels to your picture. Triangles/squares: write a sentence about your picture. Stars: write a story about your picture.</p>	<p>Fine motor: Move some tiny objects from one bowl to another; one by one. You could start off with grapes or peas but then move to something really small like rice, raisins or sequins. How many can you move in 20 seconds?</p>	<p>Diary of the week: keep a diary about your activities that week. Circles: Write initial sounds or labels to describe what you did. Triangles/squares: write a sentence to describe what you did. Stars: write sentences using words like first, next, then, yesterday etc.</p>


<p>Maths</p>	<p>2D shape recognition: Circles, triangles, squares: Practise 2D shape names by looking at pictures of examples. Do you know circle, triangle, square, rectangle, rhombus, pentagon, hexagon and octagon?</p>	<p>2D shape hunt: Circles, triangles, squares: Go around your home and complete a shape hunt. You could take pictures of what you find or create your own sheet where you draw what you find.</p>	<p>2D shape picture: Circles, triangles, squares: make a picture by drawing shapes, a collage by cutting and sticking shapes or on the computer/ipad using 'Paint' or an app. What will you make? e.g. a house or rocket Stars: count the sides of the shapes.</p>	<p>Circles, triangles, squares: Make 2D shapes using playdough, string, straws of construction kits. Can you name what you made? Stars: talk about the sides of the shapes. Are they curved or straight? Can you make a circle using sticks?</p>
<p>Challenge</p>	<p>Circles, triangles, squares: Play a board game with your family... remember to take it in turns. Stars: Make your own board game.</p>	<p>Circles, triangles, squares: Get dressed on your own. What will you choose to wear? Stars: Practise turning your clothes the right way around and doing buttons/zips.</p>	<p>Circles, triangles, squares: Make a healthy packed lunch for you and your family. What will you choose? Stars: Talk about why you made those choices.</p>	<p>Circles, triangles, squares: Go on a nature hunt and find leaves, sticks, stones, flowers and any other exciting bits of treasure. Make sure you wash your hands when you get in. Put them in a container in freeze (see picture) Stars: Talk about freezing and melting.</p>
