Phonics/ Spelling	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sound – igh</u></p> <p>Words to read and spell – flight, night, thigh, bright, high, fright.</p> <p>Can you create any alien words using the ‘igh’ sound?</p> <p>Can you write sentences about the ‘igh sound’ picture?</p> <p>Explore phonics play games and activities.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sound – ear</u></p> <p>Words to read and spell – spear, fear, hear, clear, year, gear</p> <p>Can you create any alien words using the ‘ear’ sound?</p> <p>Children to pick up a word and draw a picture to show its meaning.</p> <p>Can you create your own phonics game to test your adult?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sound – air</u></p> <p>Words to read and spell – chair, fairy, stair, hair, repair, fairground.</p> <p>Cut up ‘air images’ and lay them down on the table. Pick one up and spell the word. Can the children write a sentence for the image?</p> <p>Explore phonics play games and activities.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sound – ure</u></p> <p>Words to read and spell – cure, pure, manure, figure, secure, mixture.</p> <p>Can you create any alien words using the ‘ure’ sound?</p> <p>Can you read the phoneme spotter story? Can you find all the ‘ure’ sounds?</p> <p>Listen to the tricky word songs.</p>
Reading	<p>Get your adult to read you a story. Did you like the story? Can you explain why?</p>	<p>Retell your favourite story by acting it out. Perform it to your family. Maybe you could make puppets to perform it.</p>	<p>Find your favourite book and read it with your adult.</p>	<p>Go on Oxford owls – explore all the stories and find one you would like to read.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">or</p> <p>You could sign up to Collins to find banded books.</p>
Writing	<p>Choose your favourite fairy tale villain and write a description of them. Maybe you could illustrate your description.</p> <p>Remember your finger spaces, full stops and capital letters. Can you use conjunctions and adjectives?</p>	<p>Write a shopping list of all your favourite foods.</p> <p>Can you draw a picture for each type of food?</p> <p>Can you write a sentence using ‘because’ to explain why they are your favourite food?</p>	<p>Write a card/letter for someone in your family.</p> <p>Tell them about your day or why you love them.</p>	<p>Pick a picture and write a sentence about it.</p> <p>Remember your finger spaces, full stops and capital letters. Can you use conjunctions and adjectives?</p>

<p>Maths</p>	<p><u>Counting in 2s</u> Children to pair up all their socks and count in twos to find out how many socks they have in their drawer.</p>	<p><u>Place value</u> Children to choose a number between 0 – 50. Tell us all the different facts about that number. How can it be made? How many tens and ones do you need to make your number? Can you put it in a part whole model?</p>	<p><u>Shape</u> Go on a shape hunt... What shapes can you see? Are they 2D or 3D shapes? How do you know? Count how many different shapes you can see.</p>	<p><u>Addition and Subtraction</u> Practice you number bonds to ten and twenty. e.g $1+9=10$ and $3+17=20$ Can you make yourself a game like dominos or snap to test your knowledge?</p>
<p>Challenge</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Children to find and label the seven continents on world map. See song.</p>	<p><u>History</u> Children to describe their favourite toy from today. Encourage children to describe what their toy is and what it does, what it looks like and what it is made from.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Children to label the simple structure of a plant. See BBC bitesize.</p>	<p><u>PE</u> Choose a cosmic kids yoga video. Go on cosmic kids on YouTube and choose which one you want to do.</p>

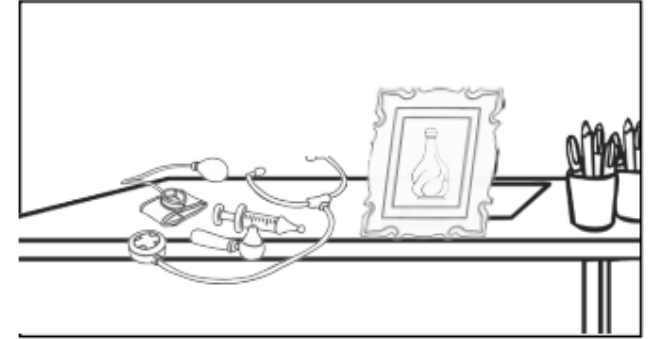
The Mixture in the Picture



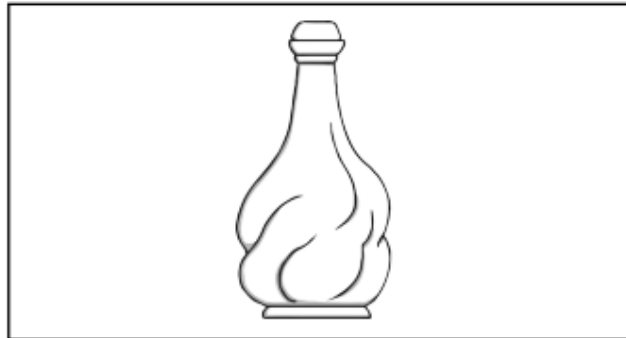
Hure was ill. In fact, he kept being sick. He had a temperature and felt too ill to get up from his bed.



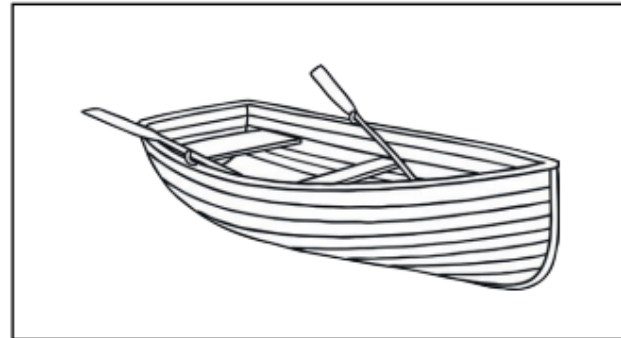
The doctor sent him to bed with a pill. The pill did not help Hure and he still felt ill.
