Other Subjects

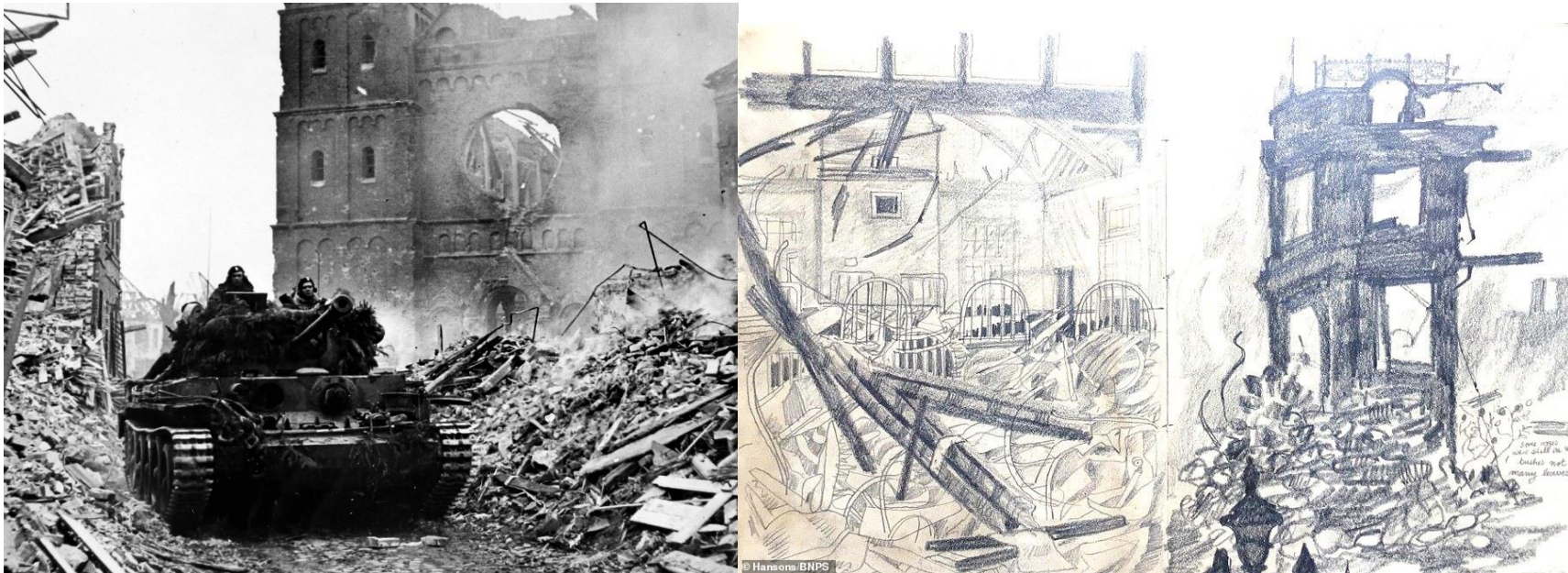
ICT
