And this is the basket to catch them all.





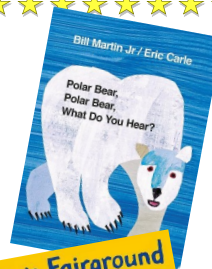
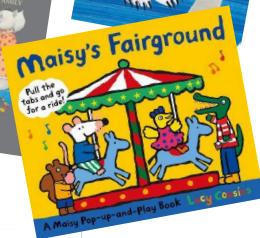
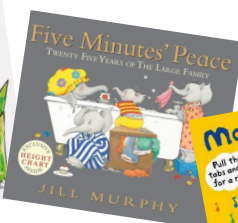
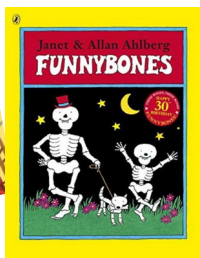

| Practise getting dressed for school. Can you draw each stage in the correct order? What comes first? | Go for a walk to look at the different houses and buildings. What are the houses made from? How does your house look different to others? | Create a picture diary of what you do each day of the week. On Monday I... etc. | Can you make some emotion pictures using loose parts e.g. buttons, string, spaghetti, pipe cleaners, beads etc. What emotion will your face show? |
