



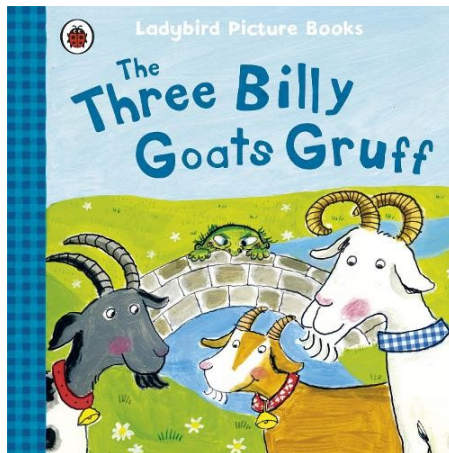

The text for this will be shared with you via Tapestry.

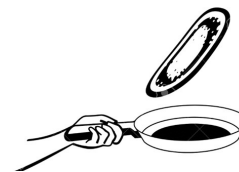

Spring 1 Topic Overview: People Who Help Us

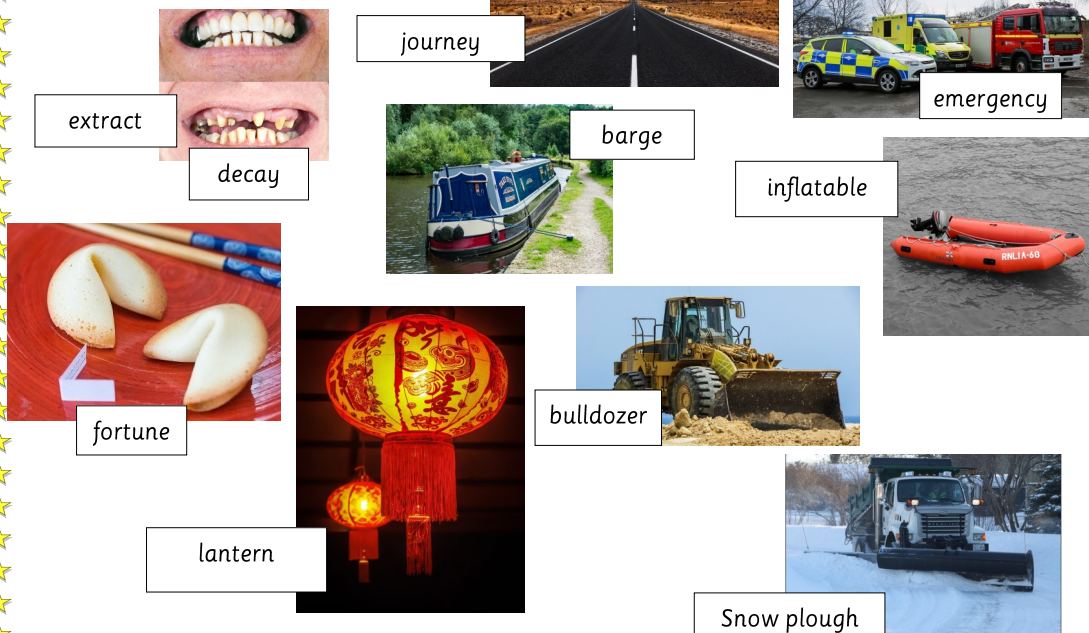
A little look into our learning journey over the course of this half term...

What will I learn?

- To learn about people who help us and occupations in our community.
- To explore how things work, move and investigate forces.
- To explore colour mixing and mix colours for purposes when recreating artistic effects.
- To recite stories using actions and repeated phrases. To innovate these stories to create their own.

Development Matters

- Talk about members of their immediate family and community.
- Name and describe people who are familiar to them.
- Describe what they see, hear and feel.
- Explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings.
- Return to and build on their previous learning, refining ideas and developing their ability to represent them.
- Retell the story, once they have developed a deep familiarity with the text, some as exact repetition and some in their own words.

Spring 1 Topic Overview: People Who Help Us

Explore the activities below to support and deepen learning throughout the course of this half term ...



Retell the Talk for Writing story/ rhyme using the text e.g. The Three Billy Goats Gruff.	Talk about the importance of tooth brushing and do this independently. Make a poster to say how we clean our teeth correctly.	Listen to the story of the Great Race: Can you draw the animals in the correct order? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=eVCLAj8q_lY	Learn about a type of vehicle. Where would you find this type of vehicle? What is it used for? What features does it have that others don't?
Learn about the phone number needed for an emergency. Can you say your full name and address independently?	Make a Lunar New Year craft 	Sort foods in your cupboards into foods that are healthy for our teeth and those that are not healthy. What ingredients do they have in them?	Go on a journey... this could be in a car, a bus or a train. What can you see? Did you have to buy a ticket? Who helps us/works there? Draw a map to show what you saw.
Explore colour mixing. What different colours can you make? What happens when you add light/dark colours into your mix, e.g. white/black?	Think about the steps needed in order to wash your hands. Learn about why it is so important to wash your hands. Can you create a poster to show your findings?	Explore floating and sinking while in the bath or in your sink. Which items float? Which sink? Why do you think this is the case?	Learn about people who help us in our community... bus drivers, postal workers, police, etc. Learn a fact about a chosen few professions that interest you.
