As historians we will...

Geography

As geographers we will...

- ◆ Identify similarities and differences between two areas and sets of data.
- ◆ Describe the key human features of a place using words like city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour, shop

As readers, we will...

- ◆ Learn to read with fluency whilst using prosody and intonation when reading a familiar book.
- ◆ We will learn to understand characters and their actions.
- ◆ We will use non-fiction books to learn about the world around us.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will...

- ◆ Year 1 will learn about multiples and begin our times table journey.
- ◆ Year 1 will also work with numbers to 100, using them to complete simple calculations.
- ◆ Year 2 will learn about fractions as well as measure, capacity and temperature.

RE

As theologians, we will...

- ◆ Learn about Humanism and what humanists believe.
- ◆ Understand that Humanism isn't a religion and is a way of living.

Science

As scientists, we will...

- ◆ Learn about animals, including humans.
